

Kane's Night to Remember

It's not very often that your night goes exactly to plan and that's why it's very important to savour the moment when it actually does happen. Last Saturday night's Grenville Anderson East Coast National at Lismore Speedway in Northern NSW was when everything came together for Darren Kane.



The Boettcher Racing Team driver not only reclaimed the inaugural event Grenville Anderson East Coast National after disappointingly failing to defend last season's event due to a crash, but he also set a new 50-lap record on his way to dominating the feature race field where he came very close to lapping the entire field, along with setting new 10-lap and one lap records earlier in the night.

"It was a night where everything just worked out perfectly for our team, as we barely touched the car all night and a lot of that came via keeping a close eye on the track and being confident with the setup that I had underneath me," expressed Kane, who had started from position three in the feature race after he had won two out of his three heat races. "Our team worked hard to amend the drama we had at the Queensland Championship, which was traced back to a problem with our differential, and it was great to bounce back from that disappointment with such a memorable night."

Kane continued on by saying that the response from everyone that witnessed his dominance throughout the Grenville Anderson East Coast National made the night even more memorable.



“Grenville Anderson is regarded the best Sedan driver Australia has ever produced and the most humbling part of winning this event in his honour for the second occasion was having people, many of whom don’t attend Speedway as much anymore, come up and congratulate me, as it gives me such great pride in what I had achieved,” Kane commented. “The field that assembled for this event was one of the strongest in the country, so that makes winning even more satisfying.”

The Grenville Anderson East Coast National also doubled up as the latest round of the Proton Queensland Series and it has, once again, seen the QLD # 36 Boettcher Race Parts supported Mazda RX8 driver consolidate his lead in the current point standings.

Kane and Boettcher Racing Team will be back in action this Saturday night (April 2) at Brisbane International Speedway for the latest round of the Proton Queensland Series.
